Children's Lawnmower Pull
Deerfield Valley Farmers' Day Fair

1. Any un-sports man like conduct will not be tolerated and will lead to automatic disqualification.

2. Registration fee is \$10.00 per driver. Pit crew members will pay \$5.00 each. **Only one pit crew member per child is permitted in the pit area. Wristbands will be issued. All members must be present at the time of check-in and registration.** A complete waiver and application needs to be filled out and signed for each child. The age requirements of children: No child younger than 5 yrs. and no older than 17 yrs. old.

NO REFUNDS

3. There will be three classes.
 - An 800 lb or less
 - 1200 lb
 - 1500 lb

NO lawn mower motors bigger then 25hp.

4. **Helmets, shoes, shirts and pants are required.**

NO EXCEPTIONS

5. Inspection of mowers will take place the day of the event. There must be some kind of wheelie bar on the lawn mower. Wheelie bars are mandatory and will be inspected at the time of

entry. **WHEELIE BARS MUST BE SAFE OR MOWER WILL NOT RUN!!**

6. Mowing deck **must** be removed for safety reasons. Governor may be adjusted. Only one engine allowed per tractor.

Maximum of 25hp or less ALLOWED. MODIFICATION TO EXHAUST IS ALLOWED.

7. Tires can be filled. **Chains are not allowed** weight may be added for stability. Weights and anything attached to the tractor must be properly secured. If the objects are not properly secured they may have to be removed.

8. Pull hitches can be made but, they must be 10 inches or less from the ground and must be solid to hold pull. Hitches must have ring or loop.

9. NO FOUR WHEEL DRIVE TRACTORS ALLOWED

10. Pull will be 25ft long. Each tractor will be pulling 35lb blocks. Weight can go up to 1,575 lbs if tractor will pull.

11. Trophies awarded to the first 5 places in each class.

12. CHILD MUST PUT ARMS IN AIR AND KEEP FEET CLEAR FROM THE PEDEL WHEN AT STARTING LINE. CHILD CAN NOT STAND UP ON LAWN MOWER WHEN LAWN MOWER IS IN THE MIDDLE OF A PULL. IF THIS IS DONE THE PULL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

13. Parent can help the child put manual transmission in gear as long as the child can run the pedals independently. Parents cannot get on or run the tractor for them. Once the tractor is in motion, parent **may not** touch tractor unless an emergency arises. If the tractor is touched the puller will be disqualified. If tractor stops pull is over.

14. **No more than 3 children per tractor.**

15. If you have time please spend some time with the child on the tractor backing up and stopping to have a safe pull. Thank you for coming and have fun.

16. Track Marshalls word is final.

All tractors, drivers and pit crew members need to be checked in by 4:15 P.M.
